



The Family Funeral Service®

In August 1907, my great-grandfather, Arthur William Lymn, conducted his first funeral, founding A.W. Lymn The Family Funeral Service. From the very start, the business has been dedicated to quality service, value for money, and meeting the needs of clients, earning a respected reputation for expertise and dedication within the Nottinghamshire, South Derbyshire and since 2024, Leicestershire communities.

Originally furniture makers, Arthur and his son Harold, transitioned into specialising in coffins and funeral services. The business grew quickly, leading to a move to larger premises in 1915. By the time of Arthur's passing in 1929, Harold and his mother Louisa were managing the business through significant challenges, including wartime rationing. During World War II, Harold even volunteered in the Civil Defence mortuary.

The company expanded further under the guidance of Harold's son, Douglas and son-in-law, my father, George Rose, and became a limited company in 1958. In 1977, after Harold's death, the firm moved its headquarters to Robin Hood House, where it remains today. The family's involvement has been key to its success over the years. Today my wife Penny, my sister Jackie and I are all actively involved, while the fifth generation, led by my son Matthew as Managing Director and daughter Chlöe as Director, manage daily operations with my nephew Ben also being involved.

With 26 funeral homes, an in-house floristry division, and the largest privately-owned Rolls-Royce funeral fleet in the world, A.W. Lymn continues to thrive. We are proud members of the National Association of Funeral Directors and the European Group of Selected Independent Funeral Homes. The business remains committed to reinvesting in our staff, facilities, and services to ensure we provide the highest level of care to bereaved families.

I am immensely proud to carry on my great-grandfather's legacy, upholding the values he established. With our deep roots in the local area, our reputation is built on experience and strong connections to the communities we serve.














First Steps

The first step should always be contact with your local funeral director who will offer help and advice any time of the day or night. Our calls are all answered by our own local experienced funeral arrangers.

Financial Advice

Dealing with finances after a bereavement can be overwhelming, but some matters need prompt attention to avoid complications.

Funeral costs can often be paid directly from the deceased's bank account with the invoice and death certificate, provided there are sufficient funds. If not, State assistance may be available, please ask your funeral arranger for eligibility criteria.

It is advisable to write a list with the following information about the deceased:-

- Accounts/Shares/ISA's etc
- Life Insurance
- Private Pensions/Annuities
- DWP/State Pension
- Utility Companies
- Council Tax
- Buildings Insurance

All these people may have to be contacted and creating a list at the start will help organise what needs to be done.

The person responsible for managing the estate will be:

- The executor, if there's a Will
- The next of kin under the rules of intestacy, if there's no Will

They can handle matters personally or seek help from a solicitor, especially for complex estates. Some solicitors offer free consultations to determine if you need their services, and you can always seek their assistance later if needed.

Registration of Death

Your funeral director cannot register the death for you - this must be done by the legally responsible person, such as a relative, executor or someone arranging the funeral. Once the doctor issues the Medical Certificate of Cause of Death (MCCD) and it is approved by the Medical Examiner and sent to the Register Office, our staff can help you arrange an appointment with the registrar. Deaths should be registered within five days of the paperwork being received by the Register Office unless the Coroner is involved.

When registering, you'll need to provide the following information about the deceased:

- Date and place of death
- Full name and any previous names (e.g., maiden name)
- Date and place of birth
- Last address
- Occupation
- Details of a deceased or surviving spouse or civil partner, including full name, date of birth and occupation
- Information about state pension and other benefits

The registrar will verify the details and you will sign the register. You can also access the "Tell Us Once" service to notify multiple government departments (e.g., council tax, DVLA, benefits, pensions).

On completion, the Registrar will issue:

- A 'green form' for burial or cremation
- A BD8 form for pension or benefits, only if you are not using the "Tell Us Once" service
- Certified copies of entry (Death certificates) £12.50 each




At A.W. Lymn The Family Funeral Service, our experienced local staff are available any time of the day or night to personally answer your calls. They can arrange the transfer of the deceased, connect you with a qualified funeral director for immediate advice, and guide you through the challenging period following a death.

Procedure following an expected death:



We recommend that families contact us immediately after a death occurs. If the death happens in a hospital, it is not necessary for us to attend immediately however our staff can provide guidance to ease your mind and explain the necessary steps. Contact details for all area offices are listed on pages 82-83.

Funeral Costs

Each funeral arranged by A.W. Lymn The Family Funeral Service includes a written estimate prepared in advance by an experienced arranger. This estimate, along with our contract, must be signed by the client, who is responsible for the payment. During this process, we will discuss funeral funding. Unlike many other funeral directors, we typically do not require payment before the funeral, though some cemeteries may request pre-payment.

The final invoice will be sent approximately one week after the funeral. If the funeral is largely funded by a pre-paid plan, any outstanding items not covered by the plan provider will also be billed at this time.

Invoices to Third Parties

Invoices can be sent to third parties (e.g. a family member, bank or solicitor), but the client remains responsible for payment.

Other Help Available

Some clients may be eligible for DWP assistance with funeral costs. Our staff can advise and assist with claims, though DWP payments won't cover the full cost. They can also assist in obtaining further help available from the government or charities.

Discounts

A £100.00 discount is available if the full estimate is paid before the funeral date.

We offer a facility of loans to our clients subject to an affordability survey through a simple system and set loan amounts. The main points are:-

- No need for loan security
- No early repayment penalty
- Loans are available from £600.00 £3,000.00.
- Interest is payable at rates ranging from 14.8% 16.9% APR

The loan agreement is made at the discretion of the lender, who reserves the right to withdraw loan offers at any time prior to an agreement being signed by both parties. Additional interest and charges will apply if the loan is not repaid in line with the terms of the agreement. Any costs incurred by the lender, as a result of the borrower defaulting on the loan repayments, will also be added to the loan balance. An extremely simple service at a family selected location, at a mutually agreed date and time, with the Funeral Director offering a poem or prayer and photographing the coffin if requested.

The Funeral With No Mourners Package includes the following:

Transfer of the deceased from the place of death (up to 100 running miles) at any time. Administration of paperwork. Attending to the necessary arrangements during office hours at our premises. We aim to carry coffins at shoulder height where possible, but conditions may prevent this. A risk assessment will be done, and your funeral arranger will advise if extra staff are needed at an additional cost or if shoulder carrying isn't an option.

Music

Most crematoria offer systems to download music for services. We can also arrange soloists, musicians, or use of our own iPods and sound systems.

PA Systems, Video Screens & Recording of Services

We can arrange PA systems for large services, video links displaying the service at additional locations and recording equipment to make a video or audio recording for the family.

Webcasting

Live video streaming allows relatives and friends, especially those abroad or unable to travel, to attend the funeral remotely.

Catering

We can assist with catering arrangements, either at a hotel, our premises, or a family member's home.

Choosing the right officiant

A Religious Minister: A minister will deliver a full religious service, including prayers, hymns and scripture, and commit the soul to God's care. If you don't have a connection to a place of worship, we can help find a minister for you. Each religion offers specific funeral options, and it's best to ask for details before deciding.

An Independent or Civil Celebrant: Civil funerals focus on the wishes of the deceased and family, not the beliefs of the celebrant. They can include religious elements like hymns or prayers but don't have to be fully religious. Celebrants are usually trained by a professional body such as the IOCF or AIC.

A Humanist Celebrant: Humanists don't believe in an afterlife or spiritual beings, so their ceremonies are non-religious. They focus on celebrating the deceased's life and achievements. Humanist celebrants are trained by Humanists UK.

All funeral ceremonies should be personal and relevant to the individual who has died. Please be aware that different types of service or ceremony may offer greater or lesser opportunities for input regarding the choice of music, poetry, personal reminiscences, life story etc. It is always wise to check with the officiant that they are willing to provide exactly the type of ceremony that is appropriate for the person who has died.
